The foodbank is supported by a team of volunteers, who gave an estimated 1,600 hours of their time freely last year.

Their work includes collecting food from supermarkets and cafes, sorting donations, packing food parcels, registering foodbank clients, making teas and coffees, and chatting to clients to help them feel welcomed and signpost them to further support.

A key part of the Foodbank is providing support to help people through their financial crisis. We worked with Citizens Advice and Turning Point to provide each of our foodbank clients access to free, on-site expert advice on debt, benefits, income maximisation, addiction and more.
